The President is pleased to grant the higher pay scale of Rs. 67,000-79,000/- (comparable to the pay scale of the IAS officers posted as Additional Secretary under the Central Staffing Scheme) to the following HAG/SAG IB(E)S officers of various batches with effect from the dates mentioned against each on non-functional basis, as per the general terms and conditions mentioned in the DC & T OM No. AB.14017/64/2008-Estt.(RR) dated 24.04.2009:-

2. The up-gradation of pay-scale granted under these orders to the officers mentioned above will be a purely non-functional up-gradation personal to these officers and would not bestow any right to these officers to claim promotion or deputation benefits based on the non-functional up-gradation of their pay scales in such a manner.

3. Pay fixation on grant of non-functional up-gradation under these orders will be done as per the provisions of CCS(RP) Rules, 2008 i.e. the officers will be granted one increment at the rate of 3% of basic pay and the difference of grade pay will be added to their basic pay.

4. As and when the normal vacancies in the grade arise, the above officers except those who have already been promoted to HAG of IB(E)S on regular basis, will be considered for regular promotion as per the normal DPC guidelines, based on the provisions of the recruitment rules in consultation with UPSC. However, at the time of promotion, the pay in the grade will not be fixed again for the above officers who have been granted up-gradation under these orders.

5. Grant of higher pay scale of Rs. 67,000-79,000/- to the officers mentioned at para 1 above and fixation of their pay in the said pay scale will be further subject to post audit and over payment, made if, any will be recoverable in lump sum.
